The Levy County Sheriff's Office is committed and will assist you before and after a hurricane.

Before the storm assistance:

- Ensuring public safety by coordinating emergency response efforts and providing assistance to residents in affected areas.
- Assist with evacuating residents from high-risk areas by providing traffic control.
- Maintaining order in the community.
- Assisting with traffic control and road closures during evacuations to ensure public safety.
- Providing security to all evacuee's in our emergency shelters.

After the storm assistance:

- Conduct frequent patrol in damaged communities.
- Assist with traffic control and road closures during restoration of essential services such as power, water.
- Conducting search and rescue operations for individuals who may be stranded or in danger.
- Assisting in removal of debris from blocked roads.
- Providing support to affected residents in accessing resources and assistance programs.
- Collaborating with local government agencies and organizations to assess the overall impact of the storm and develop recovery plans.
